**IMPORTANT NOTES**

- Routines: As detailed in the current GymSports NZ WAG or MAG requirements manual.
- Entries: and
1. All entries must be on the enclosed entry form with registration numbers full names written clearly in the order you wish them to compete.
  2. All **WAG Level 1 to Level 3** entries must show the overall start value for each gymnast. These levels may be organized into sections to give even grouping depending on the overall start values.
  3. **WAG Level 1 to Level 3** gymnasts **may not** change from one section to another once entered, but may change individual apparatus start values as long as their total remains within the range they have entered in. The Invercargill Gymnastic Club reserves the right to put a gymnast up to the next appropriate section if their actual start value is greater than that stated on the entry form **and** is in the range for the next section.
  4. **Apparatus start values** for **WAG Level 1 to Level 3** competitors **must** be written on gymnasts' ribbon cards and handed to the competition results staff **before** the start of competition.
  5. For **WAG Level 4** entries, please advise the number of red ribbons each gymnast has received at the time of entry close-off. This level of competition may be organized into two sections to give even grouping.
  6. Teams **must** be named on the entry form.
- Fees: Cheques payable to: The Invercargill Gymnastic Club.
- Numbers: All gymnasts are required to wear their 4 digit competition numbers. Non-compliance may result in deductions for each gymnast. This is as per GymSports NZ's uniform policy. Deductions will be at the discretion of the competition control judge.
- Judges & Recorders: All competing clubs are expected to provide one judge per level entered and recorders as requested. Judges names **must** be submitted on the appropriate form with athletes' entries.
- Awards: Medals and certificates will be presented as soon as possible at the end of each competition.
- Refunds: Entry fees will only be refunded on presentation of a medical certificate **within 3 days of the completion of the competition**. Refunds of entry fees for non-medical reasons must be supported by a written request **within 3 days of the completion of the competition**. The Executive Committee for the Invercargill Gymnastic Club will consider such requests on a case-by-case basis.
