ENTRIES

The entry forms are now available on the website. Please ensure you downloaded these entry forms and send the GymSports New Zealand, PO Box 9485, Newmarket, Auckland. **Entries close on July 27th 2009.** No late entries will be accepted.

DRAFT TIMETABLE

Until entries are received we are unable to provide a full timetable. However we would like to provide schools with the following details:

Saturday 5th September – Trampoline, Women's Artistic, Aerobics
Sunday 6th September – Men's Artistic, Rhythmic, Aerobics

A full timetable will be circulated to all schools entered, once entries have closed on July 27th.

SPECTATOR TICKETS

These will be available to be purchased on the day when entering the gymnasium. The charge will be \$10.00 and adult's day pass, \$5.00 child's day pass (children are 12 years and under).

ACCREDITATION PROCESS

For each gymsport there will be one adult per six athletes permitted on the competition floor at any one time. In the case of Artistic Gymnastics if there is more than one event running simultaneously, then one coach per event is permitted. This person can be a coach or a teacher.

All athletes will also be given accreditation passes. These passes allow the athletes free entry into the event and allow them to be on the competition floor while their event is in progress. At all other times non competing athletes are to remain in the spectator seating supporting their team members.

CANTEEN

A full canteen will be operating both days, with a selection of hot and cold food and drinks.

HELPFUL TIPS FOR AEROBICS ENTRANTS

- All schools and coaches should bring a CD of their Levels athletes music with them – this would include CD's from 2006-2009.
- Please label your levels CD's with the athlete's name, athlete's school, year of the CD, track number and song name on the CD.
- REMINDER the age limit is set at 31st December to allow for athletes who are also competing in GSNZ competitions

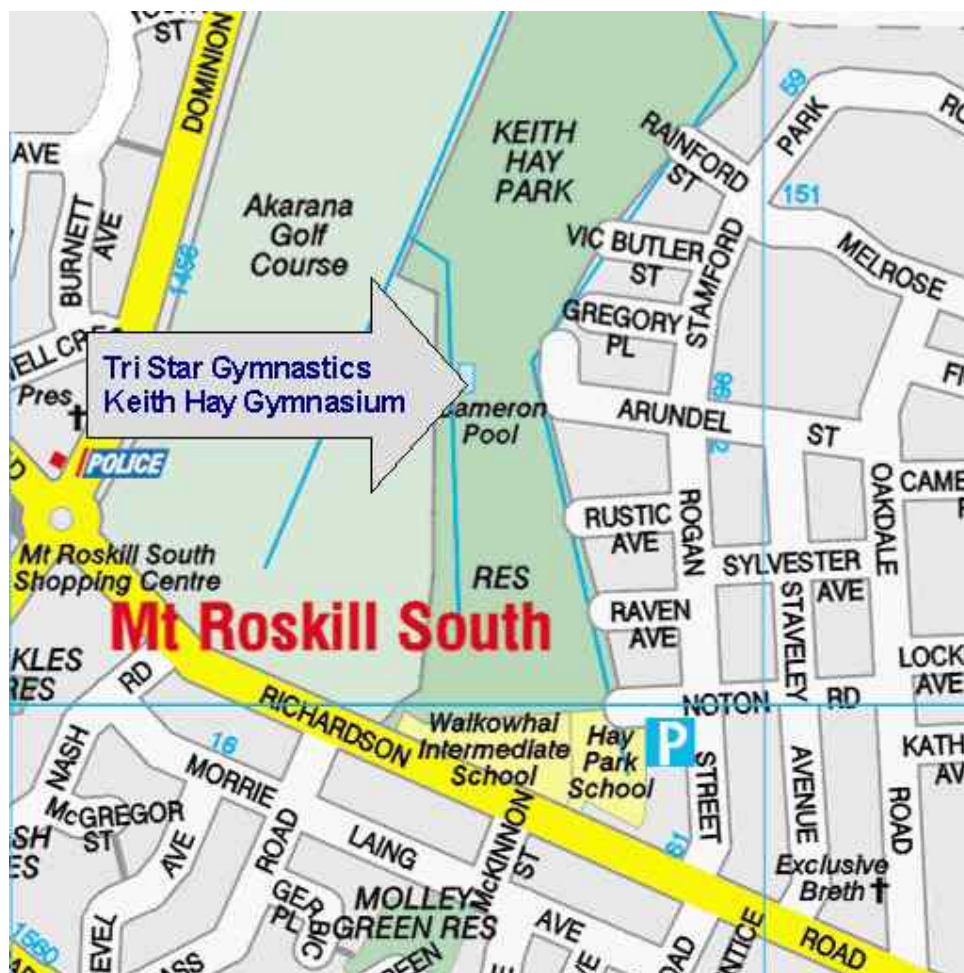
UNIFORMS
